

From the Principal

Welcome to Remote & Flexible Learning, 2.0. Thank-you to our staff, students and families for their quick turnaround in one day to get everything organised. Remember we are all here to support each other. After the first round, we worked through a reflection process about, what did and didn't work, and what we would do if we needed to return to the remote and flexible model in the future. So, heading into this round of Remote and Flexible Learning, we have changed the structure to better support students, families and staff.



This time around we have introduced whole class WebEx meetings to help maintain the connection between fellow students and classroom teachers. We have had great feedback around the class meetings from students, families and staff.

In order to work towards a greater level of engagement from all families, we have changed how our tasks may look. Our staff are working tirelessly to set tasks that are 'just right' to help increase student interest and participation. The technical teacher term for this is 'differentiation.' This happens more simply in the 'onsite classroom' but it takes more planning to support in the remote classroom. We are aiming to see development and adaptations in this space over the next few weeks.

Remember this is Remote and Flexible, so families can build a remote school timetable, to work in with your family and your life.

So, who is responsible for what areas of Remote and Flexible Learning?

Students

- Engagement in, completion and submission of tasks
- Students can message their teacher on SeeSaw if they need assistance or instructions to complete tasks



- Acting on feedback when provided
- Attendance at class WebEx meetings
- Make sure your WebEx agreements are signed with what the expectations of these meetings are!

Supervising Family/Carers

- Routines, routines, routines... Keeping normal routines (bedtimes and meal times) will be the best support you can provide
- Set clear expectations about what task work students need to complete and by when. This could be a discussion around each day's tasks
- Ensure that technical and See Saw issues are logged via the help desk. Support is on hand

School Staff

- Set appropriate learning and wellbeing tasks
- Provide feedback to students that is designed to support students doing their
- Offering advice to families to best support them to ensure they know how the platform works
- Tom, Graeme & Myself
- On any given day, at least one of us is onsite to support student welfare, but we are always contactable
- Developing professional practice activities to support staff to plan for engagement and learning in the remote space
- Whole school operations and DET requirements

Help Desk:

- Addressing help desk requests
- Offering support sessions for families, this could be a call, WebEx, etc.


